## **Program Manager**

### **Duties**

Applicant will manage and lead deployed airborne ISR operations from remote and austere locations, as well as CONUS locations supporting Operational Test and Evaluations of specialized collections equipment. Applicant must have strong leadership skills and be able to manage aircrew and maintenance personnel. Applicant must also be able to plan, coordinate and direct flight operations with daily interactions and briefings of senior military staff.

### **Experience Requirements**

Prior Special Operations and Joint Air Operations highly desired. Applicant must have experience with developing test plans and executing Operational Test and Evaluation programs. Applicant must be well versed and experienced in the planning, coordination and execution of airborne ISR as well as ground forces (SOF) Tactics, Techniques and Procedures. Applicant must be capable of drafting flight schedules, maintenance schedules and Concept of Operations (CONOPS). Joint or SOF staff experience required. Applicant should possess strong working knowledge of EO/IR camera operations, Precision Geo-location systems, and aircraft operations. A background with Science & Technology as they apply to airborne ISR is desired.
